

TRADITIONAL MOOSE HUNT

Moose hunting in Norway and Namdalen is special. When we hunt moose, we use dogs in order to force the moose to move towards shooters who are stationed at their posts. These posts have been carefully chosen based on many years of experience and knowledge about the movements of the moose during the hunting season. You will become part of a local hunting team, and as a member of this team you will be bound to follow the team's rules and plans in line with regional government regulations. The hunting guides use dogs in order to make sure that the moose moves towards the stationed hunters. In this way, we can make sure that the correct moose is shot.

Number of guest per group: 3-6 persons.

Time and length of stay: Five days in the period ranging from September 24th to November 15th.

The package includes the following: Local transport/rental car, full board accommodation in single rooms, practical shooting training at Solum Shooting Range, borrowing of weapons and ammunition, licence to hunt moose together with a local hunting team, hunting guide with a dog, moose retrieval from the forest, skinning of the moose, sauna and Jacuzzi, and good hosts.

PROGRAM

Day 1. We pick you up at Trondheim Airport Værnes. Check in at Namsentunet. Simple lunch and information about the stay, before we go to the shooting range where you will practice shooting and eventually pass the Norwegian hunting proficiency for big game hunters test resulting in a certificate allowing you to hunt moose in Norway.

Days 2, 3, and 4.

Breakfast. The leader of the hunting team will pick you up and take you hunting. Lunch is served in the forest by a campfire, and after the hunt a three-course dinner will be served at Namsentunet.

Day 5. Breakfast. Check out and departure for Trondheim Airport Værnes.
